Testing for College Admissions

Students are encouraged to take the following tests:

- PSAT
- SAT Reasoning Test or ACT
- PAA (College Board of Puerto Rico)
- TOEFL (as required)

Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take AP exams; enrollment in AP courses requires faculty recommendation.

Students enrolled in Honors courses are encouraged to take Advanced Level exams administered by the College Board of Puerto Rico in April.
